Our main event is the 5K (3.1 miles). This race is open to all age groups. The pace is entirely up to the participant. We welcome competitive runners, walkers, strollers, etc.... This race does not include the color bombs. T-shirts are included in the race entry fee but are only guaranteed to participants signed up by March 23rd. This race will begin promptly at 9am. You will need to arrive and sign in no later than 8:30am. Awards (1st-3rd) will be given out in each division.

Our 2nd event is the 1-Mile Rainbow Fun Run. This race is open to all age groups. This race INCLUDES color bombs. T-shirts are included in the race entry fee but are only guaranteed to participants signed up by March 23rd. However, we strongly recommend that you wear a solid white t-shirt to this race. (We cannot guarantee the color bombs will not stain clothing). This race will begin after the 5K has concluded (approximately 10:15). Participants will need to arrive and sign in no later than 9:30am. This race is not timed but participation medals will be awarded.
