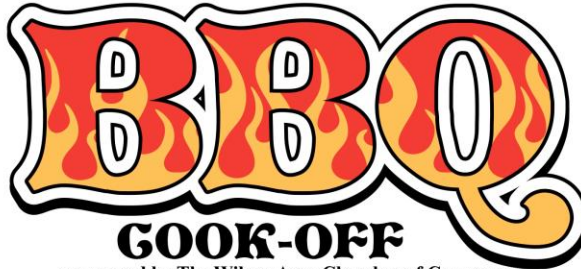

Rules and Regulations April 17, 2021

- Teams may check-in and set-up between 5:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m., Friday, April 16th. No grills can be started before 5:30 p.m. Friday, April 16th.
- Entries for the BBQ Cook-Off will have a \$100 entry fee. Categories are: Rib (beef or pork), Butts, & Chicken.
- All participants will be given styrofoam boxes for judging on the day of the competition.
- Head cook must be 21 years of age or older and will be liable for their team.
- Teams will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Cooking sites are 20x20, (2 parking spaces) at Camden Courthouse Square. Participants will be assigned location on a first come, first serve basis.
- Teams must supply ALL needed equipment, sanitation supplies and water. If you require electricity, you must provide your own generator. Generators must be turned off by 10:00 a.m. on the day of competition.
- Fire Extinguishers are REQUIRED at each cooking site.
- Inspection will be Friday between 5:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. Mandatory meetings in the Chamber tent at 6:00 p.m., Friday, April 16th.
- All meat must be raw/uncooked prior to check-in. Marinating and seasoning prior to check-in is permitted.
- Sauce must be cooked on meat and not added after removing from grill.
- Category items being judged are NOT allowed to leave your assigned cooking site and brought back. All meat must be prepared at your designated cooking site.
- Teams are allowed to cook and sell on Friday, April 16th.
- Judging will begin on Saturday at 10:30 a.m. Prizes will be awarded at 1:00 p.m. Judging times will be as follows:
 Chicken - 10:30 a.m. Ribs - 11:00 a.m. Butts 11:30 a.m.
 1st Place per category: \$500 cash and trophy, 2nd Place per category: \$300 cash and trophy, 3rd Place per category: \$200 cash and trophy. *All 1st Place winners' names will be permanently displayed on a plaque in the Wilcox Area Chamber of Commerce Building at the Gees Bend Ferry Terminal* We will add an overall winner based on how each team finishes in all categories. \$750 will be awarded to the Grand Champion.
- Tickets will be sold for \$5.00 per person for anyone wanting to judge the Taster's Choice Award.
- Judging for Taster's Choice will be on Saturday at 10:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. Tickets will not be sold prior to 10:30 a.m. or after 12:00 p.m. Taster's Choice results will not factor in Grand Champion Award. Taster's Choice: \$300 cash and plaque.
- All cooking sites must be cleaned and vacated by 3:00 p.m. Saturday. Cook sites are approximately 20' x 20' or 2 spaces.
- Teams for the BBQ Cook-Off will be those persons who have submitted the entry application with paid entry fee and been approved as having satisfactorily met the Rules and Regulations governing the contest.
